Science & Technology

➤IIT- Bombay researchers develops Dhruva chip that can be used in smart phones and receive signals from NAVIC (ISRO satellites based alternative to GPS) (23 Jun 2020)

The 55th Edition of **Top 500** (List of the world's fastest supercomputers) is out on 22 Jun 2020; the fastest "Fugaku" from Japan (not China or USA) has 415.5 petaflops in High Performance Linpack and the first # 1 system to be powered by **ARM** processor (not Intel)!

>Drones in India get license to fly long-distance as per new policy in June 2020; 13 entities including

SpiceJet and e-commerce / food distribution companies are to begin trials in July 2020

➤ Ashok Leyland introduces "fully customizable" AVTR trucks - result of 1 Million manhours of R&D (June 2020)

> Prestigious Science journals Lancet and New England J of Medicine had to retract papers in June 2020 (Covid-19 projection related)

Special events and Milestones

- > Puri Rath Yatra initially cancelled by Supreme Court finally took off with Supreme Court allowing it with limited temple staff only (and no large crowd of devotees) (23 Jun)
- **≻India** gets elected to **UN Security Council** (as non-permanent Member) for a period of 2 years with 184 of the 192 Member countries supporting it (20 Jun)
- >Adani Green Energy gets \$ 6 Billion (over 5 years) order for 8 GW solar power plant (will be the largest in the world) from Solar Energy Corporation of India on 10 June 2020
- Adani decides to back out of taking over **Ahmedabad**, **Lucknow**, **Mangalore** Airports from IAAI; **Navi Mumbai Airport** goes thru rough weather (Covid-19 impact); **Bhogapuram** green field **Airport** in **Vizianagaram** all set to take off as per June announcement
- >The iconic cycle brand Atlas Cycles becomes history with the last plant getting shut down (5 Jun)
- >Indo-China border and Indo-Nepal border tension continued in June 2020 though largely under control; talks at multiple levels (Military Commanders, Officials, Heads of State); 20 Indian Army men died at China India border on the night of 16 Jun; Defence Minister Rajnath Singh attended a meeting in Russia; both USA and Russia offering to help India in defusing the tension
- >Oil India fire in Assam throughout June causes lot of damage
- > Cyclone NISARGA spared its fury on Mumbai on; the City narrowly escaped; there were about half a dozen loss of lives near Mumbai (3 Jun)
- >Coronavirus Disease (officially Covid-19) continues to cause havoc throughout the month of June and the number of cases cross 10 Million globally and the death toll crosses half a million (30 Jun)
 - ≽<u>Lockdown Un-lock 1</u> starting **June 8**, 2020 has led to opening of economic activity; New York City also reopens on 8 June 2020; Chennai clamps lockdown again on 19 **Jun to 30 Jun**; parts of Bengaluru too got lockdown on 19 Jun; all of Bengaluru to get curfew on Sundays from 5 **Jul 2020**; <u>Lockdown Un-lock 2</u> starts from July 1; Prime Minister Modi speaks to the Nation (30 Jun)
 - >On June 30, 2020, cases / deaths stood at

 - ❖India: More than 500,000 and more than 17,000
 - ❖USA: More than 2.5 Million and 1more than 25.000+
