# In the **IPO space**

- Chennai-based LatentView Analytics IPO subscribed 326 times, the largest ever subscription for any IPO in India; gains 48% value on Day 1 (22 November 2021)
- One97 (parent of PayTM) IPO subscribed 1.89 times; it is the largest IPO in Indian history; raised 1.39 Lakh Crores (10th November 2021); however, the stock crashed on Day 1 causing much misery to early investors, lost 37% in just 2 days of listing (18 November 2021); improved a bit later (30 November 2021)
- **Nykaa** had an excellent Day 1 after IPO; market capitalisation touched Rs 1 Lakh Crores (10th November 2021)

#### Globally,

- Ericsson to acquire Inter telephony major Vonage for \$ 6.2 Billion (22 November 2021)
- Alphabet (Google's parent company) touched \$ 2 Trillion market capitalisation, for the first time (10 November 2021)
