- 1. <u>Science & Technology, Innovation & Policy</u>
 - Self-writing AI code Codex from OpenAI (AI Research Labs), debuts (10 September 2021)
 - India's highest S&T Award (Shanti Swaroop Bhatnagar Award) announced; the 2021 list has two Theoretical Computer Science researchers (of the 11 winners) Dr Debdeep Mukhopadhyay of IITKGP and Dr Saket Saurabh of IMSc, Chennai (28 September 2021)
 - **SpaceX** all-civilian (no professional astronaut) crew took off and landed safely after 4 days (15-18 September 2021)
 - MEITY announces 1000-day Policy to reach \$ 1 Trillion target for the Digital Economy (24 September 2021)
 - Government announces **80% reduction in Patent Filing Fee** to all (Public and Private) higher education Institutes (23 September 2021)
 - NARCL an Asset Reconstruction Bank (ARC) formally set up to improve the health of Banking sector (17 September 2021)
 - **Start-up friendly Procurement Policy** announced by the Government of Karnataka Government (11 September 2021)
 - China declare all crypto transaction illegal (11 September 2021)

 - Nearly 16 Lakhs take **NEET** Exam (admission test for Medical colleges) in 3,800 centres in India and abroad (12 September 2021)
 - Kotak establishes an AI Centre at IISc Bangalore (18 September 2021)

- 3. Special events and Milestones
 - Prime Minister **Modi visits USA** for 4 days; attends **Quad** (USA, Australia, Japan & India) meeting and speaks at **United Nations General Assembly** (15-19 September 2021)
 - **China's** real estate firm **Evergrande** and its \$ 300 Billion debt had global implications (September 2021)
 - **US pullout** from **Afghanistan** was complete on 31 August 2021; the new Nation is struggling to stabilise (September 2021)

- Paras Defence creates history; IPO on NSE subscribed 304 times (22 September 2021)
